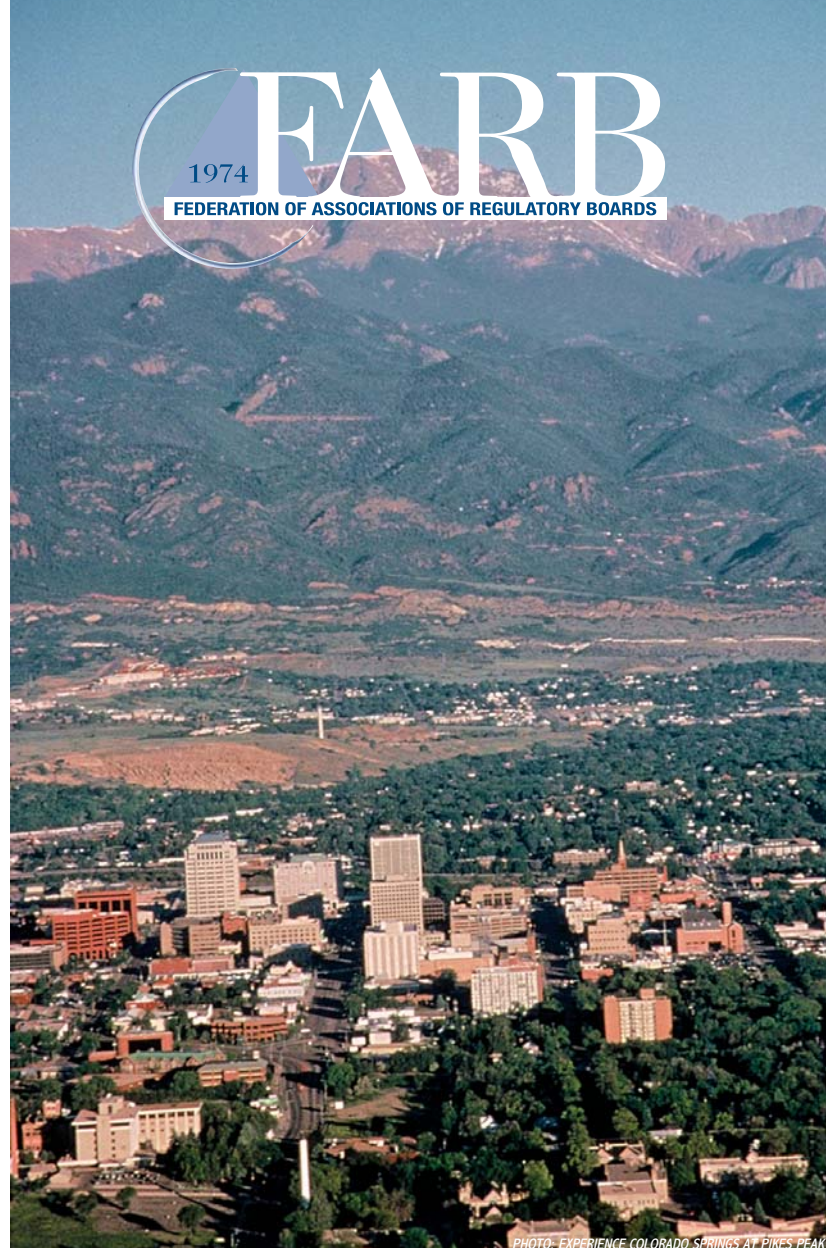


PHOTO: EXPERIENCE COLORADO SPRINGS AT PIKES PEAK

ABOUT THE SEMINAR

On behalf of its Board of Directors, the Federation of Associations of Regulatory Boards (FARB) is pleased to announce its 16th Annual Attorney Certification Seminar in Professional Regulatory Law (ACS). The seminar begins on October 3, 2008, and continues through the morning of October 5, 2008, covering numerous topics related to administrative law. The seminar will feature presentations by a variety of experts of administrative law and will include an analysis of current legal issues that impact regulatory boards and their attorneys.

COURSE CONTENT

Attendees at the FARB ACS 2008 will participate in sessions addressing contemporary issues impacting the legal representation of regulatory boards. The 2008 ACS Friday Focus will feature presenters arguing motions before the audience which will act as a hearing panel. These oral arguments will address prosecutorial and defense issues including summary suspension, recusal, collateral estoppel, newly discovered evidence, rehearing, and collection of costs and/ or attorney's fees. Additional sessions include identity theft and licensure, e-discovery, exam breaches, legal issues in post-disciplinary monitoring, uniformity in discipline, and admissions in consent orders.

In addition, the FARB ACS 2008 will also feature its popular presentations of new legislation impacting licensure and top recent regulatory cases.

LOCATION

The 16th annual Attorney Certification Seminar will be held in Colorado Springs, Colorado, at the Antlers Hilton. 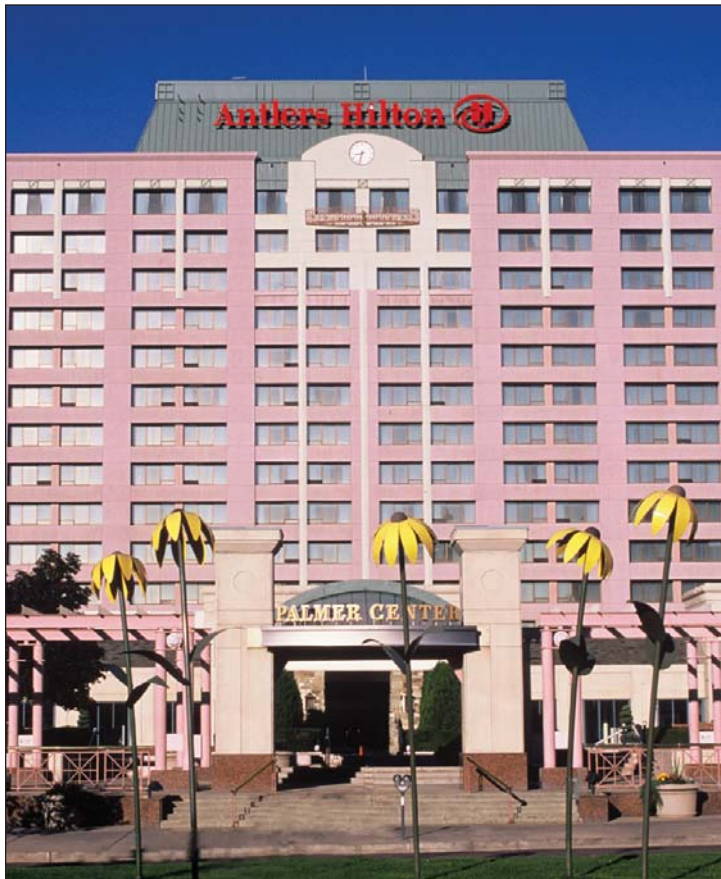
