Proposed programs must:

- » Relate to NAB's Domains of Practice
- » Enhance knowledge and skills of long term care administrators
- » Be taught by instructors with experience in the subject matter
- » Offer appropriate CE credit

Who Benefits?

» Program sponsors and providers

Single source approval accepted by most states

» Individuals who attend

Approvals valid in nearly all states requiring continuing education for license renewal

» State licensing jurisdictions

NCERS can relieve state boards of the task of approving continuing education credit for programs



Types of Programs

Proposed programs may be:

- » Seminars
- » Self study
- » Teleconferences
- » Online interactive

Programs may range in duration from one hour to multi-days.

What is **NAB & NCERS?**

The National Association of Boards of Examiners of Long Term Care Administrators (NAB) is the nationally recognized authority on licensing, credentialing, and regulating long term care administrators.

The **National Continuing Education Review Service** (NCERS) meets the needs of administrators and state boards while also meeting the needs of sponsors/providers. NCERS screens, reviews and evaluates continuing education programs - lending its seal of approval to those programs that meet high quality standards.

Why **NCERS?**

Long term care administrators are required to complete continuing education requirements for licensure renewal.

NCERS has assembled a cadre of competent long term care administrators, educators, and state board executives, who work in panels of three to review, evaluate and approve proposed programs that meet high standards.

Who accepts **NAB** approved credit?

Forty-five (45) licensing jurisdictions accept NAB credit.*
